Strengths

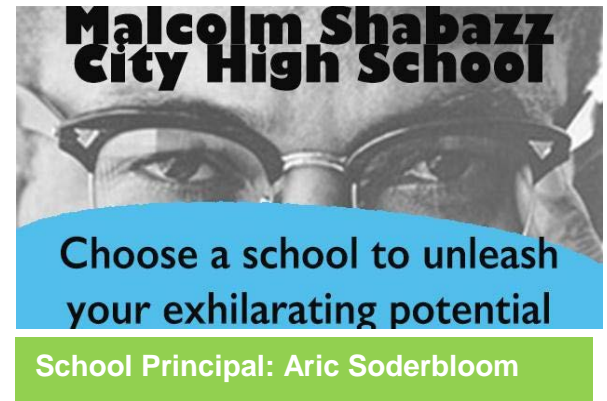
Shabazz City High School remains the school of choice for students seeking to belong to a safe, engaging, and authentic learning community, and who want to pursue 4 year post-secondary options.

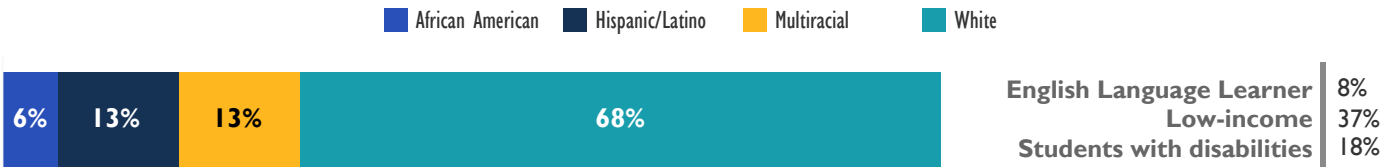

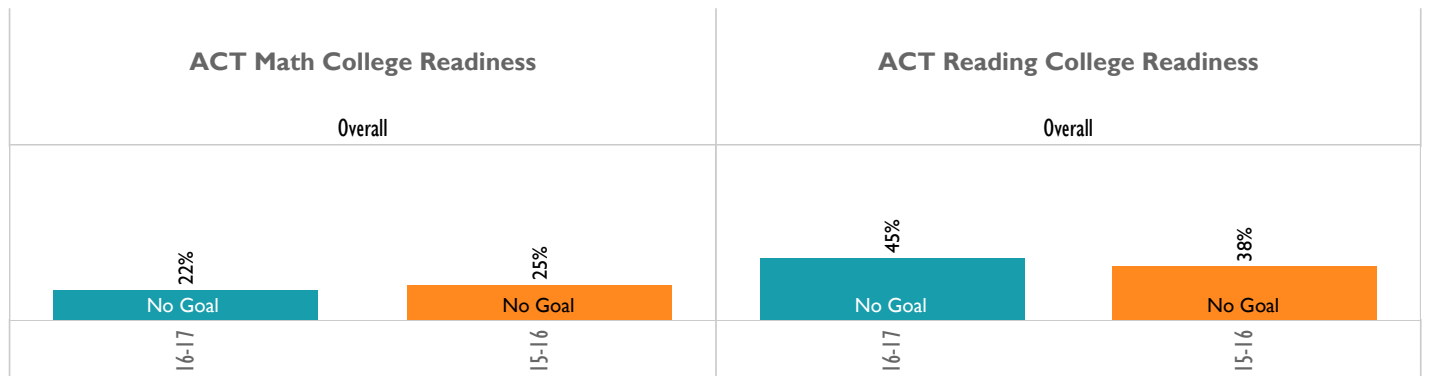

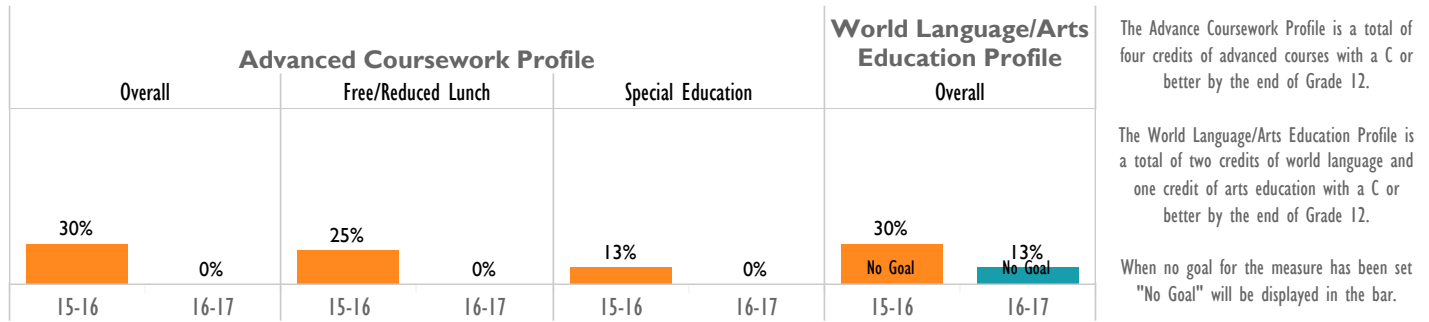


Strategic Framework Goal #1 Milestones: On-Track to Graduate
